

What is Peak Oil?

- The end of cheap oil, not the end of oil
- Peak is halfway point, after which no more oil can be physically pumped to satisfy demand
- Prices will rapidly rise
- Reflected in the cost of commodities in everyday
 life

Supply:Lines


- Mapping and tracking oil and gas pipelines



Triptich 1 - Transport








